When is the RETREAT?

Registration is open on Friday, March 12, 2010 from 6:00pm until 8:00pm. The retreat will end Sunday, March 14th at 2:00pm. Please eat dinner before arriving at registration on Friday evening.

Who can Attend?

Any young person between the ages of 13-21 years old. Youth Leaders and/or Chaperones are also invited to register.

Where is the retreat Located?

Once again, the retreat will be located at the beautiful Tuscarora Inn & Conference Center. The facility is known for its magnificent accommodations and gorgeous scenery amidst the Pocono Mountains and the Delaware River. Visit Tuscarora Inn's website at www.tuscarora.org to take a virtual tour of the facilities. The retreat is conveniently located within 2-5 hours of major Northeastern cities such as Philadelphia, New York City, Jersey City, Boston, Buffalo, Rochester, and Syracuse. How much does the retreat Cost?

The cost for the entire weekend is just \$139 for early registration and \$169 for late registration. In addition, attendees must pay a \$10.00 membership fee if they have not yet paid their 2010 YMJA Membership Dues.

When is Registration Due?

Early registration must be received by **Friday, February 12, 2010**. Late registration must be received by Friday, March 5, 2010. On-site registration is not permitted unless you make special arrangements with the YMJA by calling the office first. Keep in mind that if you register before February 12th, you save \$30. What a deal!

Where will we be Sleeping?

We will be staying in cozy, winterized cabins at the Tuscarora Inn. There are separate accommodations for ladies and gentlemen, and cabins will be chaperoned. Beds will be provided, but please make sure to bring your own linens including a sleeping bag or sheets and a pillow.

I hereby agree to release, hold harmless and indemnify, the Young Messianic Jewish Alliance and the Messianic Jewish Alliance of America, including any staff, employees, administration, affiliates, volunteers and participants of any kind from any claims for damages or money whatsoever arising out of the above referenced trip.

I also understand that the following rules as stated below are to be followed at all times.

1. The YMJA schedule/rules are to be followed at all times and deviation from that schedule will only be allowed per the Ministry Director's permission.
2. At no time shall a teen be in a room belonging to the opposite sex.
3. Alcohol is strictly prohibited on the retreat property. Any violations of this rule will result in dismissal from the retreat at the violator's expense and the banning of said violator from future YMJA conferences.
4. Illegal drugs of any kind are strictly prohibited and discovery of such will result in dismissal from the retreat at the violator's expense and the banning of said violator from future YMJA conferences. Criminal action can be taken by the State of Pennsylvania.
